Force Majeure Cancelled – CN Strike in Canada

December 4, 2009

Triple Crown's operations had been adversely affected as a result of the strike action taken in Canada on November 28, 2009 by the Teamsters Canada Rail Conference (TCRC) against the Canadian National Railway Company (CN). CN provides rail haulage services for Triple Crown between Toronto and Triple Crown's Detroit Terminal in the Melvindale, MI area.

We have been advised by CN that the strike has ended. Triple Crown has resumed normal operations in Canada.

For customers with committed service agreements or specific service requirements: Force majeure was invoked effective 7:00PM (EST) on November 29, 2009 on all traffic originating in, destined to, or moving through the above noted area. Triple Crown has cancelled Force majeure effective 6:00AM (EST) on Friday, December 4, 2009.
