Triple Crown Captures Another Top Award from Logistics Management Magazine

The editors of Logistics Management magazine wrote a very complimentary observation in their August edition: "In the Rail/Intermodal Service category this year, we find perennial top performer Triple Crown Services posting a top weighted average."

That statement, although entirely accurate, is, in fact, an understatement. Logistics Management magazine presents "Quest for Quality" awards to those that score above the average of all the carriers in each category. Generally, there are four or five carriers who are presented a "Quest for Quality" award in the Rail/



Intermodal category each year. However, Triple Crown has been the highest rated carrier in the category eleven of the past thirteen years!

The annual Quest for Quality Survey and our continual top ratings are the most objective and comprehensive appraisals of Triple Crown performance. In its 30th annual Quest survey, the magazine received over 6,000 total responses evaluating freight carriers and service providers throughout the U.S. In the Rail/ Intermodal category, logistics professionals were asked to rate carriers on On-time Performance, Value, Information Technology, Customer Service, and Equipment & Operations. From those attribute ratings, a Weighted Score was determined. TCS rated the best in Performance, Value, Customer Service, and the Weighted Score.

Triple Crown's "Quest for Quality" award will be presented at Logistics Management's celebration dinner during the Council of Supply Chain Management Personnel conference in Denver in October.
