Force Majeure Continues – Continued Inclement Weather

May 20, 2015

Triple Crown declared Force Majeure on May 8, 2015 due to two derailments resulting from heavy rains and flooding in Texas. The inclement weather has continued, and Triple Crown's operations remain affected in Texas and Oklahoma. The weather is affecting Triple Crown's terminal operations and highway service for points served by our terminal in the Dallas/Fort Worth area. In addition, we expect weather related delays on the rail lines of BNSF in the affected area. BNSF provides rail haulage services for Triple Crown between Triple Crown's terminals in Kansas City, MO and Dallas, TX.

Customers with traffic originating in, destined to, or moving through the affected areas can expect significant delays. We will restore service to normal levels as soon as possible.
